H1N1 Flu Vaccination Clinics Now Open to Everyone Over 6 Months of Age

While the vaccination clinic is open to everyone over 6 months of age, Public Health especially encourages anyone in the following groups to be vaccinated:

- Pregnant women;
- Household contacts and caregivers for children less than 6 months of age;
- Children and young adults 6 months through 24 years of age;
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel;
- Persons aged 25 through 64 who have health conditions associated with higher risk of medical complications from influenza.

When:

- Wednesday, January 6th from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, January 13th from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, January 20th from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Where:

- Public Health offices in each county in our District.
